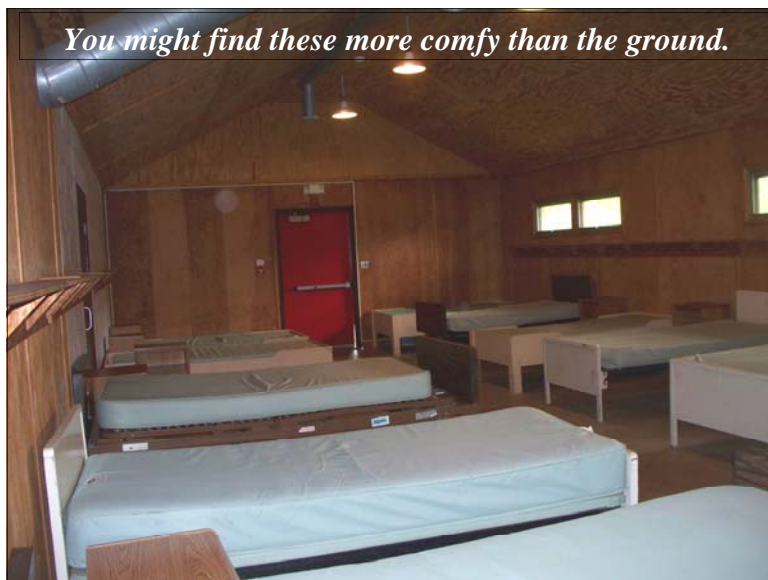


Turtle Hill Folk Festival Cabin Facilities at Rotary Sunshine Camp, Rush, NY

Is fortunate fortunate to hold our festival at this terrific facility with a long history of hosting differently-abled youngsters for a residential summer camp experience. Therefore, it is handicap-accessible—from paved paths and no steps, to modern bathroom facilities.

Cabins have beds on either side, separated by a lounge, and a bathroom accessible to either side. Users (\$10 per night, free for kids under 12) will be assigned to a cabin, but may select their bed, first come, first serve. GLFSS is not responsible for your personal belongings and cabins *will not be locked* at anytime. Bring sleeping bags, blankets, pillows, linens, etc. as you would for camping. All bathrooms provide hot water, hand soap and showers. Cabins are heated as needed.



Note: Outdoor campers are welcome to use the bathrooms and showers in the building next to the pool.



These are not luxury accommodations, and there is a certain absence of privacy as everything is shared space, except for toilets of course. We will establish one cabin for women, one for men and one for families. Additional cabins may be utilized based on interest and availability. One will be set aside for festival volunteers/staff and a performer green room.

Cabins are ideal for those wishing to stay at the festival site all weekend but prefer an indoor sleeping arrangement as opposed to dealing with all that's needed to set up a camping area in the open field..
